Subject: Quaker products food recall

On January 13th, our hospital was notified by Sysco (one of our food vendors), of a Quaker Canada recall of granola bars and certain cereals.

The affected products were recalled due to possible Salmonella contamination.

At the time of notification, we did have one of the affected types of granola cereal in stock. While some of the product had already been served in the cafeteria and The Mural Café earlier in the month, the remaining unopened boxes were removed and disposed of.

Thanks to the Food Services team for their diligence in responding to this recall and helping to ensure the well-being of our staff and visitors.

Recalls like this are not unusual in the food industry, however, we did want to ensure all members of our health care team that there are good processes in place to reduce the risk to those we serve.
