SUBJECT:	Blast Notification- COVID exposures

In order to ensure timely follow up, PRH has adapted a regional approach to contact tracing and exposure notification.

Effective immediately, staff and physicians will be notified of any potential exposures to new COVID-19 cases via "blast notification". This means, a mass notification will be sent via internal email to relevant groups identifying key information about the potential exposure. Staff and physicians will be required to review the notification and follow up with the Occupational Health and Safety team if they feel they have potentially experienced a high risk exposure.

Please monitor your PRH email regularly for these notifications. All departments are encouraged to share the exposure notifications during the shift safety huddle as well.
