

Privacy

- PRH manages all Personal Health Information in compliance with Ontario's Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 (PHIPA)
- Important privacy consideration re: PHIPA:
 - Only those who are defined as a health information custodian can collect, use or disclose PHI using implied consent.
 - For everything else, expressed consent is required.
- Privacy breaches can be prevented by:
 - Positive Patient ID before communication
 - Securing patient charts & information
 - Logging out of computers and not sharing passwords
 - Only accessing patient records where you have a duty to administer to the patient record

When a privacy beach occurs: complete RIMS report, and inform the **Privacy Officer Andrew Keck ext. 6478**, within 1 hour.
