

Safe Surgery Checklist

- Safe surgical checklists can reduce the likelihood of complications following surgery and often improve surgical outcomes.
- At PRH this standardized communication too is used during every surgical procedure and is completed by the circulating registered nurse.
- Opportunity to share information between the patient and surgical team, confirms:
 - The correct procedure
 - Procedure side/site
 - Patient information
- The checklist has three phases:
- 1. Briefing- before the induction of anesthesia
- 2. Time out- before skin incision
- 3. Debriefing- before the patient leaves the operating room
